

How to Copy and Paste your iPhoto Library

- 1) Connect manually to your Server account (so you can access your iPhoto Library).
- 2) After you have connected to the Admin Server, you should see your mounted Server folder (ex: mseward) - If not, double-click the Macintosh HD and select "adminsvr" from the left side of the Finder window. You'll see your server folder.
- 3) Select your Server folder and click on the PICTURES folder.
- 4) In the PICTURES folder, you'll the IPHOTO LIBRARY file.
- 5) Drag your IPHOTO LIBRARY file to your computer desktop.
- 6) With the Finder window still open, select your Computer folder (home) from the list on the left side of the window.
- 7) Click on the PICTURES folder to open it.
- 8) Grab your IPHOTO LIBRARY file from your computer desktop and drag it into your PICTURES folder (within your Computer account).
- 9) You may see the message "an older folder exists... replace?" Click the Replace button.
- 10) You may now launch the iPhoto program and all of your pictures should appear.

You should disconnect from the Admin Server (adminsvr) when you are finished.
