

### MCC Contest Results

The Golden Flames competed with area schools from Whitney, Joshua, China Spring, Gatesville, Bruceville-Eddy, West, Waco High, and University. Soloist Talley Gonzales received a 1st-division medal and Erin Saylor received a 2nd-division rating. The officers of Talley Gonzales and Sunny Gomez received a 1st-division trophy for their jazz routine. The team was one of the four high school dance teams to receive a 1st-division trophy. They performed two dances; pom and jazz.

### Heart of Texas Contest Results

The Golden Flames competed at the Heart of Texas Dance Contest held at Temple HS. McGregor was one of 15 teams representing schools in Central Texas, as well as schools from the Dallas and Austin areas. The Flames competed against schools with 15 members or less, regardless of the school classification. The Small-Team Division including HS teams from Early, Connally, Gatesville, Harker Heights, Lorena, Venus, and Frisco Wakeland.

Soloist Talley Gonzalez and Erin Saylor received 1st-division ratings. Talley was also 5th runner-up finalist in the small-team division.

The officers of Talley Gonzalez and Sunny Gomez received a 1st-Division Trophy on their jazz routine.

The Team performed 3 team routines, including a jazz, military, and pom. In team standings, they received first-division ratings and a Sweepstakes trophy for their three routines. They also received the Gussie Nell Davis Award of Excellence for scores of 90 or above from each judge on all team routines.

The officers received a Judges' Award for their jazz routine, and the team received a Judges' Award for their pom routine. Judges' Awards are given at the discretion of the judges and are based on presentation, regardless of the team size or division.

### Showtime's State Championship Contest Results

The Golden Flames competed at Showtime International's Texas State Championship held in Burses, Texas. McGregor was one of 15 teams representing schools from the Dallas and Ft. Worth areas and Central Texas. The Flames competed against schools with 12 members or less, regardless of the school classification. The Extra-Small Team Division including HS teams from Ft. Worth Paschal (5A), Arlington Lamar (5A), Arlington Seguin (4A), China Spring (3A), and Whitney (3A).

The Team performed three team routines, including a jazz, military, and pom. In team standings, they received first-division ratings and a Sweepstakes trophy for their three routines. In the XS team division, the Jazz Routine earned "Best in Category" and the Military Routine was first runner-up for "Best in Category".

The Flames also received the Champions Circle Trophy, which is awarded to the second-highest scoring team in each division.
