LIVE STREAMING TIPS

- Streams will play on recent versions of the major computer operating systems, mobile phones, and tablets. For computer viewers, we recommend Google Chrome as a browser, though streams will work in Firefox, Safari, and Edge. Streams will be in HD resolution if your Internet connection supports it, or will show a lower-resolution version if you are unable to reliably display the HD version.
- If you are having trouble, the most likely causes are the Internet connection at your location and the capabilities of your device or browser. You could try to use a different browser, or make sure your browser is updated to the latest version.
- If you are on a mobile device and can watch over WiFi, you will likely have a faster connection speed than over a cellular connection.
- When possible, make sure there are no other users on your same Internet connection downloading large amounts of data, watching online movies, or playing online games as this can interfere with your connection speed.
- Some older devices have graphics cards or processors that aren't able to decode video in real-time if there are too many other applications open. You might try closing other applications or even restarting your computer so there's not anything running in the background that could cause an issue.
